

ORDINANCE 2000-14

An Ordinance Of The Town Of Pegram, Tennessee Striking In Its Entirety Ordinance 1997-7 Pertaining To The Discharge Of Firearms and/or Hunting Within Town Limits


WHEREAS, on November 30, 1997, the Town adopted Ordinance No. 1997-7 which prohibited the discharge of firearms and/or hunting within Town limits except under certain circumstances and/or in areas designated as approved hunting zones.

WHEREAS, ON February 9, 1998, the Office Of The Tennessee Attorney General issued opinion No. 98-038 which opines that firearm discharges may not be restricted by a municipal ordinance and that any such municipal ordinance would not be enforceable against someone who is lawfully engaged in hunting with firearms within city limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDNED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Pegram, Tennessee, as follows:

1. Pursuant to Opinion No. 98-038 of the Office Of The Tennessee Attorney General, Ordinance 1997-7 pertaining to the discharge of firearms and/or hunting within Town limits is hereby stricken and deleted in its entirety.
