9.1 Ordinance 2023-151 An Ordinance of the Town of Pegram, Tennessee Amending the Fiscal Year 2022-23 Budget Ordinance 2022-146 to Transfer Monies within the General Fund. (1st reading)

Motion to discuss by Alderman Paszek; seconded by Mayor Louallen. There was \$300,000.00 budgeted for paving. We will need to transfer \$131,000.00 to that line item in the general fund. The plan is to have the park completed by the end of April and the other roads complete sometime in May. This is the first reading of Ordinance 2023-151 and the Public Hearing and second reading will be set for April 24, 2023. Motion to pass On first reading Ordinance 2023-151 by Mayor Louallen; seconded by Vice Mayor Bob Sanders.
